Course Overview

This course is intended for people who have little or no prior knowledge of wines. It is designed to provide a sound but simple introduction to wines. The qualification will assist those who need a basic familiarity with the main types and styles of wines, for example people who work with wines as part of a larger beverage portfolio in the retail and hospitality sectors.

Course Objective

The candidate will

- know the key stages in grape growing and wines making.
- be able to list the principal types and styles of wines, state the key characteristic of wines made from the principal grape varieties as well as other examples of wines.
- know the key principles involved in the storage and service of wine, and be in a position to answer customer queries and provide recommendations for the service of wine.

Who Should Attend

- Professionals, Service, Executive staffs from the F&B and wines & spirits industries
- Professionals, Service, Executive staffs from retail industry offering wines & spirits
- Professionals or Individuals with keen interest in wines
- Individuals seeking a career in the F&B, wines & spirits and retail industries

Course Duration

7 hours (1 day), 45 minutes examination, same day

Course Outline

- Know the key stages in grape growing and winemaking.
- Know the types, characteristics and style of wines made from the principal grape varieties and other examples of wines.
- Know the key principles and practices involved in the storage and service of wine.

Course Assessment

- 30 multiple-choice questions

Candidate must achieve a minimum of 70% in the multiple-choice question paper in 45 minutes. Same day examination.

Certification

A certificate suitable for framing and a lapel pin from **Wine & Spirit Education Trust** will be awarded upon successful completion of the course.

\$480.00 nett per person (inclusive of registration, study materials, tuition fees, samples for tasting and **one** sitting of examination)

Funding Incentive

SkillsFuture Singapore (SSG) subsidy / funding is available for Singaporeans and PRs upon achieving at least **75% attendance and successfully passing the assessment**. All subsidy / funding is subject to SSG's prevailing policies and final approval. Candidate(s) will only need to pay the nett fee (full fees less SSG pre-approved subsidy) amount upon registration. **Candidate(s) and/or Company(s) are liable for full course fee in the event that the SSG subsidy / funding are not approved.**

Subsidy / funding amount for company(s) claiming for their employees may differ from the above table. The company is required to log-in to www.skillsconnect.gov.sg for the application of all SSG subsidy / funding in the event of such claim / funding for their employee(s). Absentee Payroll may be claimable.

Full payment is required from the company(s) to complete the registration. The company(s) will be required to submit a claim within thirty (30) days from the course start date. Wine Language Pte Ltd will then disburse the claim amount back to the company(s) via cheque, upon approval from SSG / SkillsConnect.

SkillsFuture Credit

Singaporeans aged 25 years and above with SkillsFuture Credit (SFC) may utilise their credit for payment of course fees.

Post-Secondary Education Account (PESA)

Singaporeans with PESA funds may utilize it to pay for his own or his sibling's (where applicable) course fees. If the candidate(s) has both SFC and PESA funds, the order for usage will be SFC first, followed by PESA funds. Eligible candidate may download the PESA form via this [link](#). PESA funds is available until the age of 30, before the balance fund is transferred to Central Provident Fund (CPF) Ordinary Account (OA).

Attendance Guarantee Deposit

Wine Language Pte Ltd shall collect an Attendance Guarantee Deposit (ADG) from the candidate(s) applying for subsidy / funding for courses that are SSG / SFC / PSEA approved. The ADG amount will be equivalent to the claim amount. AGD will be refunded to the candidate via cheque, payable to their name after they have completed the enrolled course and after SSG /SFC / PSEA has disburse the claim amount to us.
