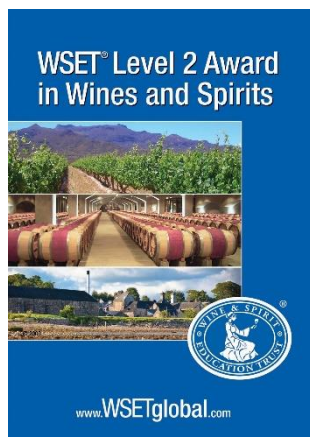


WSET® Level 2 Award in Wines and Spirits
