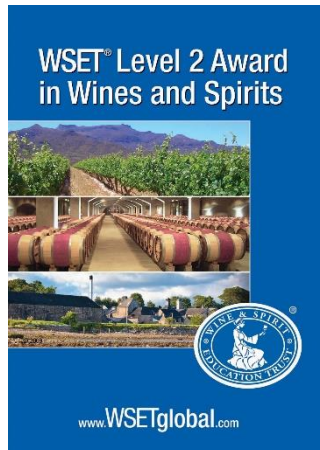


# WSET® Level 2 Award in Wines and Spirits - ODL

- Ideal for those seeking flexibility in learning. Studying at their own pace


# WSET® Level 2 Award in Wines and Spirits - ODL

## How It Works
