Course Overview

The newly acquired skills will allow the staff to upsell the alcoholic beverages and provide a better service to their customers.

- LO1: Set up beverage equipment needed for beverage preparation
- LO2: Recommend standard alcohol beverages and food pairings to customers
- LO3: Prepare standard alcoholic beverages using appropriate preparation techniques to meet customer requests.
- LO4: Prepare standard alcoholic beverages using appropriate standard recipes to meet customer requests.
- LO5: Apply the correct strength, taste, temperature and appearance for each standard alcoholic beverages prepared.
- LO6: Present drinks attractively in appropriate glassware according to organisational standards.
- LO7: Inspect the replacement of soiled workstation and service items to prepare for the next delivery
